GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Attends the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department Game Warden Training Center. Work involves receiving instruction on applicable statutes, regulations, and skills required to be a commissioned Game Warden. Works under close supervision, with minimal latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgment.

Maintains satisfactory performance while receiving and demonstrating knowledge and skill in responding to inquiries and presenting educational programs to the public regarding applicable statutes, regulations, and Department programs.

Maintains satisfactory performance while receiving and demonstrating knowledge and skill in preparing and submitting reports required by Department procedures and other agencies and courts.

Performs related work as assigned.
