## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Performs entry-level psychological work. Work involves assisting in providing psychological services to patients. Works under close supervision, with minimal latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgment.

## GENERAL QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES

### EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION

Experience in psychological work. Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major coursework in psychology or a related field is generally preferred. Experience and education may be substituted for one another.

### KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of personality theories, dynamics of behavior, projective tests, counseling techniques and procedures, and behavioral research methodology.

Ability to conduct psychological diagnoses, to administer psychological treatment, and to communicate effectively.
