
Based on information **self-reported** by the agency, the following items are noteworthy.

Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Employees

The agency's full-time equivalent (FTE) employee limitation increased by 21.1 percent to 286.6 FTEs in fiscal year 2020 compared with fiscal year 2019. Compared with fiscal year 2016, the agency had an increase of 31.2 (13.8 percent) in the total number of FTEs. Additionally, in fiscal years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020, the agency employed 1.6, 4.9, 4.1, 2.2, and 1.3 federally funded FTEs, respectively. Those FTEs do not count toward the limitation.



Excluding interagency transfers, the turnover rate within the agency (6.4 percent) was lower than the statewide turnover rate (18.6 percent) and lower than the turnover rate of Article IV agencies (10.4 percent) during fiscal year 2020. The fiscal year 2020 agency turnover rate including employees who transferred to another state agency or higher education institution was 6.4 percent.




Compensation Information^a

The average agency salary of \$64,526 in fiscal year 2020 represented a decrease of 12.7 percent compared with the average agency salary in fiscal year 2016. In fiscal year 2020, 67.4 percent of employees were paid below the midpoint of the salary range in which they were assigned. Total agency expenditures for salaries and benefits were higher compared with fiscal year 2016.
