

Based on information **self-reported** by the agency, the following items are noteworthy.

Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Employees

The agency's full-time equivalent (FTE) employee limitation remained the same in fiscal year 2022 when compared with fiscal year 2021. Compared with fiscal year 2018, the agency had a decrease of 2.1 (10.3 percent) in the total number of FTEs.




Compensation Information^a

The average agency salary of \$78,337 in fiscal year 2022 represented a decrease of 6.3 percent compared with the average agency salary in fiscal year 2018. In fiscal year 2022, 53.3 percent of employees were paid below the midpoint of the salary range to which they were assigned. Total agency expenditures for salaries and benefits were lower compared with fiscal year 2018.
