

Based on information **self-reported** by the agency, the following items are noteworthy.

Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Employees

The agency's full-time equivalent (FTE) employee limitation increased by 12.0 percent to 234.0 FTEs in fiscal year 2022 compared with fiscal year 2021. Compared with fiscal year 2018, the agency had an increase of 2.7 (1.5 percent) in the total number of FTEs.



The average agency salary of \$81,816 in fiscal year 2022 represented an increase of 21.8 percent compared with the average agency salary in fiscal year 2018. In fiscal year 2022, 34.8 percent of employees were paid below the midpoint of the salary range to which they were assigned. Total agency expenditures for salaries and benefits were higher compared with fiscal year 2018.



Fiscal Year 2022 Workforce Demographics ^c

On average, employees at the agency were 44.4 years old and had 6.6 years of agency length of service. Of the agency's employees, 64.0 percent were 40 years old or older, and 58.9 percent had fewer than 5 years of agency length of service. The Employees Retirement System estimates that between fiscal years 2022 and 2026, 23.0 percent of the agency's workforce will be eligible to retire (based on fiscal year 2022 data).
