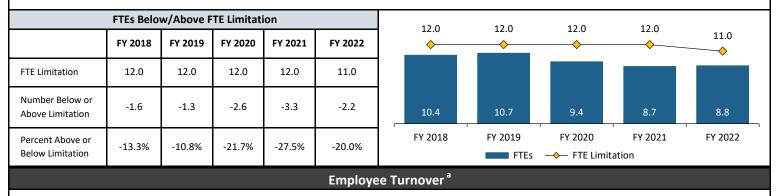

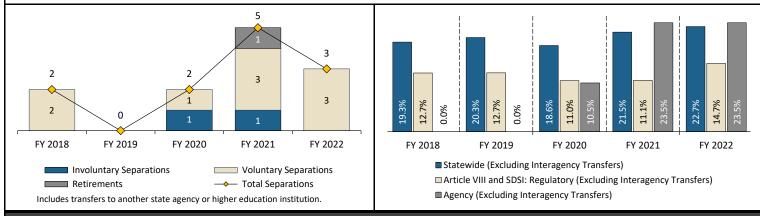
Based on information **self-reported** by the agency, the following items are noteworthy.

## Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Employees

The agency's full-time equivalent (FTE) employee limitation decreased by 8.3 percent to 11.0 FTEs in fiscal year 2022 compared with fiscal year 2021. Compared with fiscal year 2018, the agency had a decrease of 1.6 (15.4 percent) in the total number of FTEs.



Excluding interagency transfers, the turnover rate within the agency (23.5 percent) was higher than the statewide turnover rate (22.7 percent) and higher than the turnover rate of Article VIII and Self-Directed, Semi-Independent (SDSI) agencies (14.7 percent) during fiscal year 2022. The fiscal year 2022 agency turnover rate including employees who transferred to another state agency or higher education institution was 35.3 percent.



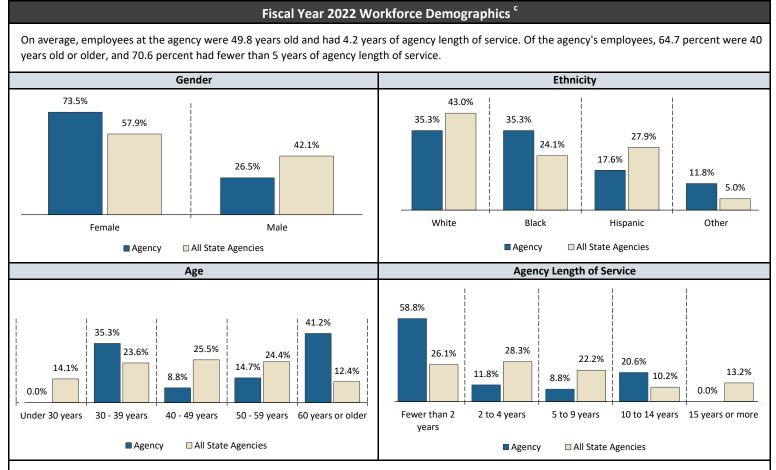
## **Compensation Information**<sup>a</sup>

The average agency salary of \$50,755 in fiscal year 2022 represented an increase of 11.3 percent compared with the average agency salary in fiscal year 2018. In fiscal year 2022, 53.1 percent of employees were paid below the midpoint of the salary range to which they were assigned. Total agency expenditures for salaries and benefits were lower compared with fiscal year 2018.
