
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

Based on information **self-reported** by the agency, the following items are noteworthy.

Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Employees

The agency's full-time equivalent (FTE) employee limitation decreased by 2.8 percent to 17.5 FTEs in fiscal year 2024 compared with fiscal year 2023. Compared with fiscal year 2020, the agency had a decrease of 0.8 (4.3 percent) in the total number of FTEs.





Compensation Information ^a

The average agency salary of \$82,476 in fiscal year 2024 represented an increase of 26.6 percent compared with the average agency salary in fiscal year 2020. In fiscal year 2024, 33.9 percent of employees were paid below the midpoint of the salary range to which they were assigned. Total agency expenditures for salaries and benefits were higher compared with fiscal year 2020.



Fiscal Year 2024 Workforce Demographics ^c

On average, employees at the agency were 45.1 years old and had 4.0 years of agency length of service. Of the agency's employees, 52.3 percent were 40 years old or older, and 82.5 percent had fewer than 5 years of agency length of service.
