

Retirements

The average agency salary of \$73,234 in fiscal year 2024 represented an increase of 19.7 percent compared with the average agency salary in fiscal year 2020. In fiscal year 2024, 61.2 percent of employees were paid below the midpoint of the salary range to which they were assigned. Total agency expenditures for salaries and benefits were higher compared with fiscal year 2020.







Fiscal Year 2024 Workforce Demographics ^d

On average, employees at the agency were 46.4 years old and had 9.4 years of agency length of service. Of the agency's employees, 70.2 percent were 40 years old or older, and 35.5 percent had fewer than 5 years of agency length of service. The Employees Retirement System estimates that between fiscal years 2024 and 2028, 25.0 percent of the agency's workforce will be eligible to retire (based on fiscal year 2024 data).
