
## **513 - Funeral Service Commission** Workforce Summary Document prepared by the State Auditor's Office. Based on information **self-reported** by the agency, the following items are noteworthy.

## Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Employees

The agency's full-time equivalent (FTE) employee limitation increased by 45.5 percent to 16.0 FTEs in fiscal year 2024 compared with fiscal year 2023. Compared with fiscal year 2020, the agency had an increase of 1.6 (17.0 percent) in the total number of FTEs.




The average agency salary of \$63,505 in fiscal year 2024 represented an increase of 31.2 percent compared with the average agency salary in fiscal year 2020. In fiscal year 2024, 15.4 percent of employees were paid below the midpoint of the salary range to which they were assigned. Total agency expenditures for salaries and benefits were higher compared with fiscal year 2020.
