

Compensation Information^a


The average agency salary of \$54,158 in fiscal year 2024 represented an increase of 28.8 percent compared with the average agency salary in fiscal year 2020. In fiscal year 2024, 31.3 percent of employees were paid below the midpoint of the salary range to which they were assigned. Total agency expenditures for salaries and benefits were lower compared with fiscal year 2020.
