

Based on information self-reported by the agency, the following items are noteworthy. Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Employees The agency's full-time equivalent (FTE) employee limitation increased by 5.0 percent to 21.0 FTEs in fiscal year 2024 compared with fiscal year 2023. Compared with fiscal year 2020, the agency had a decrease of 2.5 (12.7 percent) in the total number of FTEs.



Excluding interagency transfers, the turnover rate within the agency (12.1 percent) was lower than the statewide turnover rate (16.5 percent) and higher than the turnover rate of Article VIII and Self-Directed, Semi-Independent (SDSI) agencies (10.0 percent) during fiscal year 2024. The fiscal year 2024 agency turnover rate including employees who transferred to another state agency or higher education institution was 12.1 percent.



Compensation Information^a


The average agency salary of \$59,819 in fiscal year 2024 represented an increase of 22.0 percent compared with the average agency salary in fiscal year 2020. In fiscal year 2024, 69.7 percent of employees were paid below the midpoint of the salary range to which they were assigned. Total agency expenditures for salaries and benefits were equal compared with fiscal year 2020.
